She has since lived in New Orleans; Charleston, WV; the New Jersey-New York area; Chicago; Washington, D.C. and now lives in Houston, Texas with her husband of 34 years. "I am so thankful to have been born into a Christian family and home! From their lives on the reservation through all of Dad's work related transfers, I witnessed my parents journey of faith and commitment to the Lord. What a blessing!" Carved onto the "couple's" tombstone that sets above her father's grave is their testimony: JESUS LED US ALL THE WAY.
